Subject and predicate for class 5 CBSE

Subject and Predicate are the Parts of the Sentence. We know very well that a simple **sentence has two main parts — Subject and Predicate**. Without any subject or predicate no sentence will make any sense so it is important to have both these in your sentence to convey the entire message or for making a complete sense.

What is Subject in English grammar?

We know that in a sentence there are two main parts namely Subject and Predicate

The first part of the sentence is **Subject which tells what and who is performing an action and tells us who and what the sentence is talking about**. It may be a name, pronoun, or thing.

Subject and Predicate Examples for class 5

What is Predicate in English Grammar?

Predicate is the second part of the sentence. The **Predicate of the sentence consists of a number of words that express the action done by the Subject or tells us what the subject does or is**. Predicates include the **Verb, Principal, Auxiliary verb**.
