

Preposition for Class 4

Definition of Preposition: A preposition is a word or phrase that indicates or expresses a specific place time position or direction in a sentence. However, it shows the relationship between a noun or a pronoun and some other words in a sentence. Let us look at some examples using prepositions.

Examples:

- 1. I am at my office right now.
- 2. You are in trouble now.
- 3. He did not laugh at you.
- 4. Sonu is standing beside Ram.
- 5. My mom is in her room right now.
- 6. I am at my location right now.
- 7. She is not working here for you.
- 8. I am going to her house.
- 9. He is playing cricket with his friends.
- 10. Hove to work with your team now.

How many types of Prepositions are there?

There are 3 types of prepositions:

- 1. Preposition of time
- 2. Preposition of position
- 3. Preposition of direction

1. Preposition Of Time

Prepo<mark>sition of time indicates a specific period of time in which action takes place. At, in, on, etc. are some prepositions of time.</mark>

Examples:

- 1. It is not hot in the afternoon today.
- 2. My birthday is on the 1st of June.
- 3. We talked to him in the evening today.
- 4. He has been working **for** six months.
- 5. She will have completed the work by evening.

2. Preposition Of Place



The preposition of place indicates a specific point and distance from one place to another. *Under, above,* and *into* are some prepositions of position.

Examples:

- 1. That is your pink bag **on** the table.
- 2. Your bat is under the bed now.
- 3. This book is kept **between** the two chairs.
- 4. He sat among his college friends today.
- 5. The girl was standing beside me.

3. Preposition Of Direction

Prepositions of direction are associated with motion so it describes the direction when the person or thing moves or travels through or indicates direction. *Towards, along, on,* and *in* are some prepositions of direction.

Examples:

- 1. He is going to market with me today.
- 2. I am coming from my home right now.
- 3. She has jumped into the pool recently.
- 4. The price goes up due to this news.
- 5. Gold price may go down tomorrow.
