

Synonyms and Antonyms For Class 3

Today we will learn about Synonyms and Antonyms which increase vocabulary and develop writing skills in children.

Synonyms

Synonyms are words that have similar meanings or same as another word. It is used when the same words appear again and again, and overlaps with each other.

Examples:-

The **synonyms of abolish** are:

- Cancel
- Nullify
- Invalidate

When the word 'abolish' in the sentence appears again and again, we can use any of its synonyms.


