

Subject and Predicate for Class/ Grade 2

A sentence consists of two parts:

1. Subject
2. Predicate

Let us learn them in detail.

1. Subject

The subject in a sentence tells us whom or what the sentence is about.

Example:-

- Maya is learning English.

In the above sentence, the **subject is Maya** and the sentence is telling about her.

2. Predicate

The predicate in a sentence tells **what the subject do or does** an action in a sentence.

Example:-

- Maya is learning English.

In the above sentence, the **predicate is learning English** as it is the action done by the subject in the sentence.

Let us learn about more examples of Subject and predicate.

Maya is an intelligent girl.

Vaibhav is a brave boy.

The teacher is teaching Maths.

The girls are having get together.

She will perform on stage.

They are going to picnic.

Rupali is eating an apple.

Saloni buy a beautiful gown.
