What is a Noun?

Definition: A noun is a 'naming word'. The names of *things, persons, places, feelings* are all classified under Noun.

Kinds of noun

There are four types of Nouns in English grammar.

1. Common Noun
2. Proper Noun
3. Collective Noun
4. Abstract Noun
5. Material Noun


Noun for kids

Common Noun	Proper Noun	Collective Noun	Abstract Noun	Material Noun
Common noun refers to the name common to all persons or things of the same kind.	Proper noun refers to the name of a particular place, person or thing.	Collective Noun refers to the name of a group or collection of many taken together.	Abstract Noun refers to the name of a feeling, state of mind or quality, something which cannot but only felt.	These are the nouns that refer to the names of materials or substances out of which things are made.
Example: boy, girl, city, book, etc.	Example: Taj Mahal, Ganges, New Delhi, etc.	Example: crowd, herd, fleet, etc.	Example: honesty, bravery, etc.	Example: Gold, iron, food etc.

Raghav an honest **man** leads the **army** with **honesty**.

In the above sentence, **Raghav** is a Proper Noun **Man** is a Common Noun **army** is a Collective Noun **honesty** is an Abstract noun.

Common noun

Definition: Common noun refers to the name common to all persons or things of the same kind, e.g. boy, girl, city, book, etc.

10 examples of common noun for kids

1. I saw a little **boy** shivering with cold.
2. The **cat** ran after the mouse.
3. **Boys** play in the field.
4. Sharda has read many **books**.
5. My **umbrella** is very costly.
6. **Trees** give us **fruit**.
7. Cow gives **milk**.
8. **Water** is useful for health.
9. **Butter** is necessary for life.
10. Jaipur is the **Paris** of India. (**important sentence** 'In this sentence proper noun convert into a common noun.')

Proper noun

Definition: Proper noun refers to the name of a particular place, person or thing, e.g. Taj Mahal, Ganges, New Delhi, etc.

10 examples of Proper Noun for kids

1. **Akbar** was a great king.
2. The **Taj Mahal** is in Agra.
3. **Mr. Ratan** is a man of great knowledge.
4. This house belongs to **Aman**.
5. **Ashoka** was a fearless king.
6. **Ram** is my friend.
7. I live in **Delhi**.
8. She gazed at the **stars**.
9. **Riya** often misses her college.
10. **London** is a beautiful city.

Collective Noun

Definition: Collective Noun refers to the name of a group or collection of many taken together, e.g. **crowd**, **herd**, **fleet**, etc.

10 examples of collective noun

1. The hall was full of **audience**.
2. A **flock** of sheep was grazing in the fields.
3. A **band** of musicians.
4. A **board** of directors, etc.

5. A **bevy** of girls, women, officers, etc.
6. A **bunch** of grapes, key, etc.
7. A **bundle** of sticks and hay.
8. A **caravan** of merchants, pilgrims, travellers.
9. A **chain/range** of mountains of hills.
10. A **choir** of singers.

Abstract Noun

Definition: Abstract Noun refers to the name of a feeling, state of mind or quality, something which cannot but only felt, e.g. honesty, bravery, childhood, etc.

Note: Abstract nouns can be formed from adjectives, verbs and common nouns by adding a 'suffix' to them.

From common Noun	From Verbs	From adjectives:
Child-childhood	Choose - choice	Happy - Happiness
Slave - Slavery	Create - Creation	Enjoy - Enjoyment
Hero - Heroism	Know - Knowledge	Kind - Kindness
Friend - Friendship	Laugh - Laughter	Wise - Wisdom

10 examples of Abstract noun

1. I expressed my **gratitude** to him.
2. **Honesty** is the best policy.
3. **Beauty** lies in the eyes of the beholders.
4. His **anger** destroyed everything.
5. London is a **beautiful** city.
6. Her actions caused a lot of **embarrassment** to her parents.
7. **Beauty** is only a nine days wonder.
8. **Laughter** is the best medicine.
9. **Poverty** is the greatest curse.
10. **Success** seems to come easily to certain people.

Material Noun

Definition: Material noun is the nouns that refer to the names of materials or substances out of which things are made. or the name of something which is tangible.

10 examples of Material noun

1. **Gold** is an expensive metal.
2. **Cotton** is a natural fiber.
3. **Water** is essential for us.
4. **Copper** is a useful metal.
5. My ring is made of **gold**.
