In 1928, he became the President of the Indian National Congress. This could be wherever the Jawaharlal Nehru era began within Congress. Jawaharlal Nehru's political introduction

1929 was a turning point in Nehru's life when he presided over a session of the Indian National Congress in December. During this session, the need for 'Governance' was raised by Congress. That the British Government refused. On the Gregorian calendar, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru declared the Asian country Associate in Nursing a 'independent nation' in 1930 in the dark banks of the Ravi watercourse in the dark and wrote his name in gold letters on historical pages. It is considered the same date because the foundation, in the month of Gregory's calendar, 1950, this date was confirmed to enable the Republic to operate within the country.

From 1930 onwards, everyone began to see Gandhi's successor as Jawaharlal Nehru. From Gandhi's direct action in the 1930's to the Asian Declaration of the 1942 Movement, he played a prominent role in all the stated movements and fought for an encouraging role. therefore the order of the independent Asian country was given to them. Azad therefore became the country's prime minister.

In 1950, soon after the introduction of the Republic in the country, wholehearted hearts were gathered in the process of the country. He is referred to as the designer of the newly emerged Asian countries. Taking a key step in the country's development, in 1951, a five-year five-year establishment was forced. Until 1964, he breathed his last while working for the country.
