

Singular and Plural for Class 2

Countable Nouns/Common Noun have to Numbers:-

1. Singular Number
2. Plural Number

Singular Number

A Noun is said to be singular when it shows only a single person/ one Person, Place, animal, bird, things. Let's understand with this Example, Boy means one boy.

We add a, and an before a Singular Nouns. Like **A bat** means **one bat**.

Examples – a boy, a fan, a table, a rat, a bat, a flower, a hen, a kite, a parrot, a hat, a man etc.

Plural Number

A noun that stands for more than one *person, animal, place or thing* is said to be in the **plural number**.

Examples – *Two boys, Three birds, Four apples, Three tables, Two pens, Five chairs, Six cats.*

Singular and Plural Rules for class 2

Rule 1: Addition of 's' to change into Plural form. (Most of the nouns take 's')

For Example : Hen – Hens, Rat- Rats, Boy- Boys, Book- Books

Singular	Plural
A cow	Two cows
A tree	Two trees
A book	Four books
An Apple	Three apple
An Egg	Four Eggs
An Umbrella	Five Umbrellas
A Students	Thirty Students
A Bird	Six Birds
A parrot	Ten Parrots
A Rat	Seven Rats

Rule 2: Add 'es' when nouns end in- **ch, x, s** and **ss**.

For Example : A Branch- Two branches, A class- Three classes, One Box- Two Boxes

Singular	Plural
Box	Boxes
match	matches
Brush	brushes
Branch	Branches
Glass	Glasses
Watch	Watches
Bench	Benches
Six	Sixes
Beach	beaches
Lunch	Lunches

Rule 3 : Nouns that end in a 'vowel + Y' take the letter 's'.

For Example : Day- Days

Singular	Plural
donkey	donkeys
ray	rays
Key	keys
Valley	valleys
essay	essays
Guy	Guys
Joy	Joys
Trey	Treys
bay	Bays
Kidney	Kidneys

Rule 4 : Nouns that end in a 'consonant + Y' take the letter 'ies'.

For Example : Baby – Babies

Puppy	Puppies
Fairy	Fairies

Rule 5 : Noun that end in 'o' take 'es'.

For Example : Mango – Mangoes

Rule 6 : Some Nouns that end in 'o' take only 's'.

For Example : Photo – Photos

radio	radios
piano	pianos
studio	studios
zoo	zoos
boo	boos
kangaroo	kangaroos
kilo	kilos

shampoo

shampoos

ratio

ratios

Rule 7 : Some nouns ending in 'o' may take both 's' or 'es'.

For Example : Buffalo – Buffalos/Buffaloes

Singular	Plural
buffalo	buffaloes/buffalos
cargo	cargos/cargoes
volcano	volcanos/volcanoes
zero	zeros/zeroes
banjo	banjos/banjoes
halo	halos/haloes
mango	mangos/mangoes
motto	mottos/mottoes

Rule 8 : Noun that end in 'f' or 'fe' usually change the f sound to v and add 's' or 'es'.

For Example : – Thief– Thieves

Singular	Plural
life	lives
leaf	leaves
knife	knives
wife	wives
hoof	hooves
housewife	housewives
half	halves
thief	thieves
shelf	shelves
loaf	loaves
self	selves

Rule 9 : Some nouns are exception, they end in 'f' or 'fe' but they do not change the f sound to v, They take 's'

For Example : Giraffe – Giraffes

Singular	Plural
giraffe	giraffes
cafe	cafes
cliff	cliffs
roof	roofs
belief	beliefs
safe	safes
gulf	gulfs
chef	chefs
bluff	bluffs
handkerchief	handkerchiefs
chief	chiefs
reef	reefs
Proof	Proofs

Rule 10: There are several nouns that do not follow any rules and have irregular plural form.

For Example : Teeth – Tooth

Singular	Plural
